ALL GRADE LEVELS, ART & MUSIC

Box of tissues

Hand sanitizer

Clorox wipes

KINDERGARTEN

5 glue sticks

1 composition notebook with child's name
(primary - ½ blank, ½ lined)

3 8-pack crayons

1 16-pack of crayons

2 thin dry erase markers

1 backpack with child's name on it

4 plain folders with pockets

1 package of pencils – not jumbo

1 box of tissues (optional)

1 Clorox wipes (optional)

1 box sandwich size zip-lock bags (optional)

All items, except backpacks, will be shared in the classroom. Please label child's name only on their backpack, notebook, and folders.

Because we are a half day kindergarten, we do not eat lunch at school. Children are allowed to bring a small snack each day (something that can be eaten in 10 minutes or less).

GRADE 1

3 12-pks of **sharpened** #2 pencils (no pencil sharpeners)

1 supply box (no soft sided/zippered bags)

2 boxes **16** count CRAYOLA crayons-(**No Markers or colored pencils**)

2 or 3 big glue sticks (**no bottles**)

1 pair safety scissors

1 book bag

3 (1 red, 1 blue, 1 green) **plain** folders with pockets and 3 prongs (plastic, if possible)

2 composition notebooks

1 pk "black, skinny" Expo dry-erase markers

1 old, clean sock to use as an eraser for slates

1 pk pencil cap erasers and/or 1 large pink eraser

2 highlighters

1 box snack & quart size zipper bags – optional

Please do not put child's name on any supplies, except book bag and supply box.

GRADE 2

2 boxes of #2 wooden pencils (no mechanical pencils)

5 1-subject notebooks

5 glue sticks

1 box 32, or less, count crayons

1 pack of loose leaf paper – **wide ruled**

1 1-inch 3 ring binder with pocket (no trapper keepers) – **Mrs. Ontko's class only**

1 pair Fiskars brand scissors

5 dry erase markers (dark colors only)

5 plastic pocket folders

1 box quart zip-loc bags - optional

Important – dry-erase eraser

No pencil boxes, please

No pencil sharpeners, please

GRADE 3

3 packs of #2 pencils

1 small box of crayons

Pack of red ballpoint pens

Several erasers

3 glue sticks

1 pair of Fiskars scissors

4 Black Expo dry-erase markers

2 packs of loose leaf paper, wide ruled, stored in class

5 solid color pocket folders (plastic) with 3 fasteners (green, red, blue, orange, and yellow)

2 1-subject wide ruled spiral notebooks

Girls – 1 box of quart sized Ziploc bags - optional

Boys – 1 box of gallon sized Ziploc bags - optional

GRADE 4

3 packages of #2 pencils

Several erasers

1 box of crayons (24 or less) **OR**

1 box of colored pencils

2 pens (blue or black)

1 pair of scissors

3 three-pronged folders with pockets-any color (1-green, 1 yellow, 1 blue)

1 binder with a package of 6 dividers

3 packs of loose leaf paper (**wide ruled**)

1 bottle of glue or 2 glue sticks

2 highlighters (1 yellow, 1 pink)

2 dry erase markers and eraser

1 **zipper** pencil bag

1 book bag

Girls – 1 box of quart sized Ziploc bags - optional

Boys – 1 box of gallon sized Ziploc bags - optional

GRADE 5

2 boxes of #2 pencils – at least 20 pk
2 pens (purple, red, green or blue)
4 highlighters - any color
1 box of colored pencils or markers
4 dry erase markers with erasers
2 packs of loose-leaf paper-wide ruled
Folders (pockets and prongs)
 2-yellow, 2-green, 2-purple, 2-red,
 2-blue, 2-color of your choice
1 pair of scissors
small pencil bag
2 glue sticks
3 1" binders
1 small pencil sharpener
1 black and white composition book
1 3-subject spiral notebook
2 boxes of tissues – optional
Girls – 1 box of quart sized Ziploc bags - optional
Boys – 1 box of gallon sized Ziploc bags - optional
